Hi, I'm Claire Hamilton. I'm the Chief Executive of the London Borough of Redbridge. I've been at the council for about three months now and I'm building a team of really positive, can-do creative people who can take the council to the next level.

Great moment in time at Redbridge with a new Chief Executive and relatively new leader and we share the same level of ambition for the council and for our borough.
